The Central Library Consortium (CLC) is a Central Ohio Library system serving a four county area consisting of 14 member libraries containing nearly 1 million titles and over 4.7 million holdings. Member libraries include Alexandria, Bexley, Columbus Metropolitan, Fairfield County, Grandview Heights, London, Marysville, Pickaway County, Pickerington, Southwest, Upper Arlington, Wagnalls Memorial, Worthington, and Plain City.

## Library Membership

There is no age restriction to obtain a library card however patrons under 18 years of age must have a legal parent or guardian present. Adults 18 years and older may obtain a library card with a valid photo ID showing their current and correct residential address.

New card recipients will be placed into a 3 month new membership period. During this time new cardholders may check out up to 2 each of audiovisual materials and periodicals, then supplement their checkout with books for a grand total of 10 items per card. At the end of the 3 month new membership period patrons in good standing will be given full borrowing privileges. Patrons with fines/fees of more than \$5.00 at the end of their new membership period will be placed into another new membership period once fines and fees have been paid to below \$5.00.
